


Class of 1959 Memorial High School Eau Claire, Wisconsin Newsletter – April 2016

Eau Claire from Minneapolis and St. Paul. There are, however, numerous vans that shuttle people back and forth to and from the airport in the Twin Cities each day. To make reservations for the shuttle, you can contact the Chippewa Valley Airport Service and make reservations ahead of time.

An alternate plan would be to fly to Eau Claire through Chicago. A flight from Chicago comes in and flies out of Eau Claire in the early afternoon each day.

Rental cars are available at the airport and at other places in the area.
